- To maintain a register of qualified dental technicians and dental prosthetists entitled to practice in NSW;
- To arrange an examination and determine the standards to be achieved in those examinations for eligibility to practise as dental technicians and dental prosthetists;
- To promote the establishment in NSW of courses of training for persons wishing to become dental technicians or dental prosthetists;
- To inquire into the competence of registered dental technicians and dental prosthetists to practise and suspend or cancel registration or practising certificates, as appropriate

Purpose and Objects of CORA

The purpose of CORA is to establish and maintain national standards and processes for the regulation and education of dental prosthetists and dental technicians within Australia.

The objects of CORA are to advise and make recommendations to any State or Territory regulating authority for dental prosthetists and dental technicians including but not limited to:

recommendations for and establishment of national standards for regulation of dental prosthetists and dental technicians;

recommendations for establishment of national standards for dental prosthetist's and dental technicians premises and dental laboratories;

consultation with and provision of advice to relevant State, Territory and Commonwealth agencies on national competency standards, and associated qualifications, for dental prosthetists and dental technicians;

industry accreditation of those courses;

facilitation of mutual recognition standards within the trans-Tasman area;

consultation with and provision of advice to registration bodies with regard to assessments for persons trained as dental prosthetists and dental technicians outside the trans-Tasman area;

establishment and maintenance of a national data base relating to these objects;

consultation with and provision of policy advice to State, Territory and Commonwealth governments on regulation and associated matters related to dental prosthetists and dental technicians;

consultation with and provision of policy advice to organisations representing dental prosthetists, dentistry, dental technicians and the general public on issues relating to dental prosthetics and dental technology.
